Equity - Equal oppoturnities and inclusion in vocational education and training for young refugees and migrants

The Finnish multiplier event of the Equity project was organized in Eduko on March 14, 2023.

The goal of the Multiplier event was to spread information as widely as possible about the purpose of the Equity project and especially the results.



Participants from nearby educational institutions and the city of Kouvola were invited to the event. The City of Kouvola is a large partner and employer, and many of their industries have employees and students with immigrant backgrounds working and learning on the job. The staff of the own educational institution and guests were also invited.

The event was attended by

38 people from the aforementioned
invitees, and 28 of them
were from outside our own organization.



During the event, the participants received information about the purpose of the Equity project, what kind of goals the project has had, how the project was started during the Covid era and how the work has progressed in international work groups.









In addition to the general presentation, a workshop was organized at the event. The topics of the workshop included, among others

- integration tools, working life awareness
- integration tools, professional language and the development of language skills
- cultural awareness; Non Violent Communication
- staff training; an immigrant as a student or colleague, cultural awareness



In the workshop there was an opportunity to view a slide show related to teacher training, learn about the importance of culture as a shaper of behavior and test various materials and games for developing professional language skills, as well as materials for developing working life skills and a personal development plan.

The participants also had the opportunity to network with each other and hear each other's experiences, e.g. student guidance and working life cooperation.







Flyers with a link to the project's homepage and general information about the project were distributed to the participants. In addition, they were able to take with them some examples of the materials produced in the project.

The feedback from the event was positive and many hoped for more detailed training for their work community, both about concrete tools and cultural knowledge.
