<b>Disadvantages of a tool:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>No free version available</i></li> <li>• <i>Potential Data collection by Microsoft</i></li> </ul>
<b>Your own experience with a tool:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Various students evaluations at the end of teaching periods done and results directly shared with the students: sometimes extra recommendations from the students were being given</i></li> <li>• <i>Ideal use for decision making on e.g. any class decisions</i></li> <li>• <i>Classroom tests: multiple-choice answers will be varied automatically regarding the order of appearance</i></li> </ul>
